You may be asking, "Why are you making changes in the kit?" Well, new editions are costly and disruptive, so we limit edition changes to once every three to five years. In the meantime, however, companies come and go, certain fabrics may become unavailable, and sometimes we find errors. So each time we reprint the index, or every year or so, we introduce changes that make it as up-to-date and accurate as possible. Please note the following changes which will be reflected in the next index printing. However, remember due to kits currently in our inventory or in your bookstore's inventory, you may still for some time be using earlier printings that do not reflect these updates.
